

At Arizona Specialized Gynecology, our Providers are available on-call after hours for emergencies by calling our main office number 602-265-1112. This is a courtesy service to our patients for EMERGENT situations only.

Examples of gynecologic emergencies may include:

- Abnormal vaginal bleeding, soaking a heavy flow maxi pad or super tampon/hourly
- Post-Operative pain, bleeding, or signs of infection that are outside the normal range discussed during your pre-op appointment
- Severe urinary symptoms such as blood or pus in the urine, pain or burning with urination ACCOMPANIED with pelvic pain, fever/chills, flank pain.
- Possible allergic reaction to a new medication prescribed by one of our Providers.

You may be advised to call 911 or go to your nearest Emergency Room for evaluation

Patients with NON-Gynecologic emergencies must call during normal business hours for a same-day appointment, or go to the nearest Urgent Care or Emergency Room for evaluation.

Examples include:

- Vulvar or vaginal itching, burning, or discharge changes
- Suspected STDs
- Missed or late periods
- Suspected pregnancy
- Spotting or bleeding during intercourse
- Painful intercourse
- Medication refills or medication questions.
- UTI symptoms such as frequency, urgency, odor without pelvic pain, fever/chills, or flank pain.

If you feel you have an emergent need and wish to speak to the Provider on-call, please have ready your pharmacy information including the telephone number, your current medications, and any known drug allergies.
